PADDLER'S COMMITMENT FORM
"Water drops for a wave of hope"

1. Registration :

1. Festival registration fees, including 2 practices, are \$60.00 and needs to be paid before May 18, 2018.
2. We ask that you pay your registration fees directly to your team captain. The captain will then make a check payable to the « CARMEN Foundation » which will cumulate the fees of many paddlers.
3. Registration fees are non refundable but are transferable.
4. Each paddler promises to raise a minimum of \$200.00 in pledges as a fundraising activity for the Centre CARMEN.
5. Tax receipts will be issued for all pledges of \$20.00 or more.

2. Security :

1. All participants must wear a certified life vest at all times while in the boat.
2. Your own personal floating device (life vest) may be used if it bears the Canadian Coast Guard Approval label.
3. It is strictly prohibited to consume alcoholic beverages before or during any of the races. A paddler caught consuming alcoholic beverages before or during the races will be disqualified and risks the disqualification of their entire team from further racing activities.
4. All participants must have signed a waiver form in order to partake in the practices and the festival activities.
5. The team captain is responsible for ensuring that all fees, pledges and forms have been duly completed and signed by all members of his team.
6. All participants must attend at least one of the 2 scheduled practices.

3. Communication :

1. Communication between the Festival committee and the teams will be done via the team captain. The team captain is responsible for ensuring each member of his team has received all the committee's messages and to answer any of their team's questions.
2. *I understand that the organizing committee is managed by volunteers and I promise to adhere to all of the festival's rules and regulations.*
